1 What is this form for?

- This form can be used if you want to withdraw your appeal.
- You can withdraw an appeal at any time until a decision has been issued by the Immigration and Protection Tribunal (the Tribunal).

2 How do you submit this form?

- You may submit this Withdrawal of Appeal by post or in person to the Tribunal at the address at the end of this form.

It is an offence under the Immigration Act 2009 to make any statement, provide information, evidence or submissions knowing that they are false or misleading in any material aspect in any appeal or application in the nature of an appeal to the Tribunal.
