FORMAL REPORT UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE NEW ZEALAND BILL OF RIGHTS ACT 1990 IN RELATION TO THE CHILDREN, YOUNG PERSONS, AND THEIR FAMILIES AMENDMENT BILL

Pursuant to section 7 of the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990, the Attorney-General brings to the attention of the House of Representatives proposed section 15B contained in clause 4 of the Children, Young Persons and Their Families Amendment Bill.

That proposed section appears, notwithstanding the provisions of section 5 of the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990 (which relates to justified limitations), to be inconsistent with the rights and freedoms contained in section 14 of the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990.
