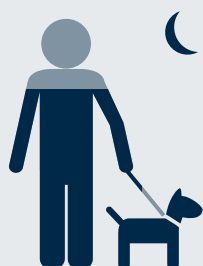


How safe did people feel in their neighbourhood?

Perceptions of crime in 2014



72% of people felt safe alone in their neighbourhood after dark

Includes people who said they felt 'very safe' and 'fairly safe'

58% of women

▲ UP FROM 52% IN 2009

86% of men

▲ UP FROM 80% IN 2009

Includes people who said they felt 'very unsafe' and 'a bit unsafe'

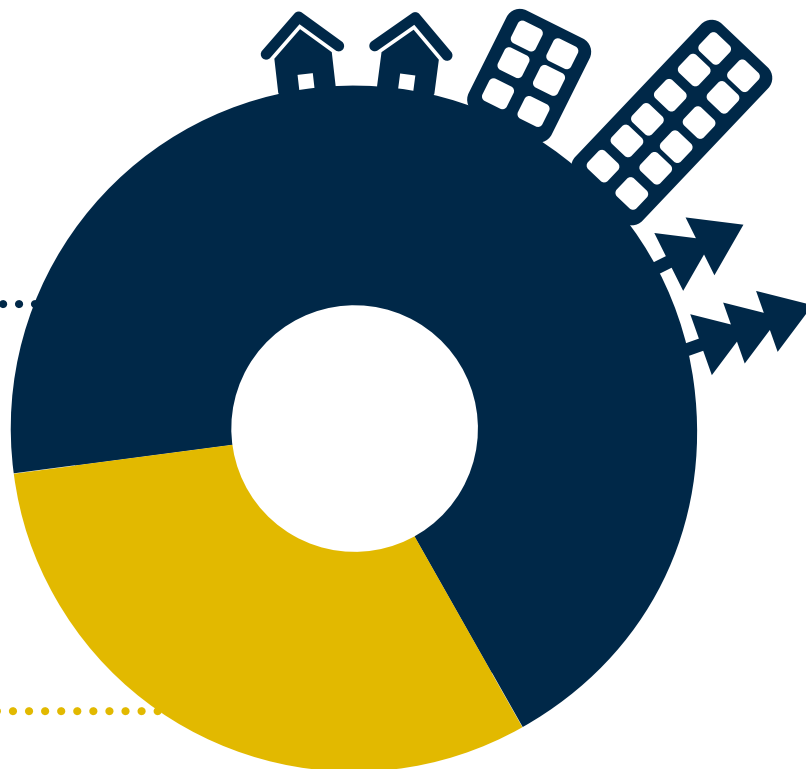
How safe did people think their neighbourhood was?

Perceptions of crime in 2014

69%

of people didn't think there was a crime problem in their neighbourhood

▲ up from 65% in 2009



Of the people who thought there was a crime problem in their neighbourhood:



- around 7 out of 10 people thought burglaries and break-ins were a problem



- around 7 out of 10 people didn't think neighbourhood crime had increased in the last 12 months
