



## **SOUTH ISLAND LANDLESS NATIVES ACT – TOITOI (STEWART ISLAND) LAND BLOCK – DETERMINATION OF SUCCESSORS AND INTERESTS**

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Hon Minister of Māori Affairs has made application to the Māori Land Court under the provisions of section 455 of the Ngāi Tahu Claims Settlement Act 1998, Part 15.5 of the Ngāi Tahu Deed of Settlement and section 29 of Te Ture Whenua Māori Act 1993 to determine and identify the current successors and their interests in the South Island Landless Native Act Block commonly referred to as the “TOITOI (STEWART ISLAND)” land block as described in Schedule A below which is currently vested in the Her Majesty the Queen upon trust for the Māori owners.

The Chief Registrar of the Māori Land Court has, having considered the derivations from the original grantees listed in Schedule C, upon investigation, now produced a list of potential successors in the block.

Any person who can whakapapa to one of the original grantees of the “TOITOI (STEWART ISLAND)” land block and who believe that they have been omitted or someone else has been omitted or someone is not entitled to be included, have **six months** from the date of this notice to make their objections in writing to the:

All objections must be on the prescribed form and accompanied by a **statutory declaration and whakapapa evidence** to support the claim – such evidence can be, but is not limited to, Māori Land Court minutes and orders, probate documentation, letters of administration or other such official documentation.

The Registrar will review the grounds for each objection and at the end of the six month period will provide a collated report of all objections received and any recommendations for amendment which will be referred to the Māori Land Court for further consideration and/or determination.

Please note that persons who lodge a notice of objection may be required to attend a Court hearing in Christchurch or such other venue to give evidence in support of their claim and notice of any hearing will be forwarded prior to any hearing.

A copy of the prescribed form of objection is set out below in Schedule B.
