DECISION

- [1] The Registrar filed a Statement of Complaint. It identified the complaint was referred to the Tribunal in respect of concerns the adviser was negligent, incompetent, incapable, and engaged in dishonest or misleading behaviour.
- [2] However, the Registrar's Statement of Complaint identified the facts supporting the complaint are based on the adviser ceasing his practice, and failing to complete work he had undertaken. There was no potential foundation for the dishonesty or misleading behaviour alleged.
- [3] The complainant then asked to withdraw the complaint.
- [4] The adviser lodged a Statement of Reply. He took the position he completed his task and Immigration New Zealand issued the visa. Accordingly, he discharged his obligations to the complainant.
- [5] Neither the Registrar nor the complainant challenged the contents of the adviser's Statement of Reply.
- [6] The Tribunal is satisfied the parties' positions regarding the complaint are correct. The Tribunal accordingly dismisses the complaint pursuant to section 50(a).
