JUDGMENT (NO 3) OF JUDGE B A CORKILL (Extension of freezing order)

[1] On 23 October 2020, I issued a further amended freezing order, which was to continue until 9.00 am on 5 November 2020, unless prior to that date it was continued or renewed.¹ The significance of that date was that applications for discharge of the freezing order were scheduled to be heard the previous day.

[2] However, in making the arrangements for the intended hearing, I noted there was a possibility that a variation of the timetable may be necessary, if the parties were to decide that a related matter be heard at the same time.

[3] Today I have received a joint memorandum from counsel indicating that they agree that the applications to discharge the freezing orders, and a challenge to an interim injunction made in the Employment Relations Authority, should be heard together.²

[4] The parties have agreed a timetable of necessary prehearing matters, which I will set out in a minute to be issued today.

[5] I record, however, that the hearing will take place at 10.00 am on1 December 2020.

[6] By consent, I extend the current freezing order to 9.00 am on2 December 2020. Leave is reserved to any party to apply for any necessary direction in respect of the further amended freezing order, on one business day's notice.
