CONSENT JUDGMENT (NO 2) OF JUDGE K G SMITH (Application for leave to extend time)

- [1] Vernon Coetzee has challenged the Employment Relations Authority's substantive and subsequent costs determinations relating to his employment relationship problem with Oamaru Meats Ltd.¹
