

**IN THE MATTER OF**

A Complaint made by **THE POLICE**  
against **MESUI TUFUI** under s 74 of the  
Private Security Personnel and Private  
Investigators Act 2010 (the Act)

**DECISION**

[1] The Police have filed a complaint against Mesui Tufui as he has been convicted of murder attempted murder and possession of methamphetamine. He was sentenced to life imprisonment with a non-parole period of 19 years. The convictions and the prison sentence are grounds for disqualification under s 62 of the Act.

[2] As grounds for disqualification now apply to Mr Tufui, I must cancel his certificate if I am satisfied that because of this he is not suitable to hold a certificate. Mr Tufui's offending was extremely serious. In addition, he is a patched member of the Comanchero Motorcycle club. Membership of such a gang also means that Mr Tufui is no longer suitable to be a certificate holder.

[3] Mr Tufui's certificate of approval is cancelled effective immediately.
