ORDER FOR COSTS

- [1] This cost order arises from an application for a review of a decision by the Standards Committee of the New Zealand Law Society.
- [2] The application was made by the respondent against the applicant following the applicant's non-attendance at a review hearing on 29 April 2009.
- [3] The applicant, having been earlier informed that his application for review might properly be determined on the papers, nevertheless sought a hearing in person. A hearing date was accordingly arranged and attended by the respondent and his advocate. The applicant did not attend, and did not give prior notice that he would not attend.
- [4] The overall circumstances relating to the application were considered, including submissions by the review applicant, and a decision made to award costs against the applicant in favour of the respondent. The full reasons for the costs order are recorded in a decision made pursuant to section 211(1)(a) of the Lawyers and Conveyancers Act (the Act) and dated 2 June 2009, in respect of the applicant's complaint.

court.
