DECISION

[1] Police have applied to cancel Dhrumik Pandya's certificate of approval as he was convicted of assault on a person in a family relationship on 19 February 2024. This is an offence of violence and therefore grounds for disqualification under s 62 of the Act and a mandatory ground for cancelling Mr Pandya's certificate under s 82 of the Act.

[2] Mr Pandya's certificate of approval was suspended after he was charged with the offence. He did not attend the hearing or provide any written response to the police complaint against him.

[3] Based on the evidence before me I am satisfied that a ground for disqualification under s 62 of the Act applies to Mr Pandya and because of this he is no longer suitable to be a certificate holder.

[4] I therefore make the following orders:

- a) Mr Pandya's certificate of approval is cancelled effective from the date of this order.
- b) Mr Pandya must return his security ID to the PSPLA within seven days of the date of this order. Failure to do so is an offence under the Act.
