When to use this form

Use this form to apply for a certificate of approval to enable you to work for a licence holder in the private security industry. You can apply for a certificate in one of nine categories. These categories are listed in Step 3.

What you need with your application

To complete your application, you need to send:

- A fully completed form
- A Valid photo ID (Passport, New Zealand driver licence, Kiwi Access card or New Zealand firearms licence)
- A passport style photo (Selfies will NOT be accepted)
- The fee for filing this application (\$600 or \$620 if you are also applying for a temporary certificate)

Completing this form

- You can fill in this form electronically. If you do, you must print, sign, and submit it to the Authority.
- You can also print and fill in this form by hand. Use a black pen or blue pen, and print clearly IN CAPITALS.
- Answer every question on the form unless the instructions tell you otherwise.

Payment information

The fee for filing an application for;

- A certificate of approval is \$600
- Temporary certificate of approval is an additional \$20

Application process

In normal circumstances, it will take a month to hear the outcome of your application.

If you have a criminal conviction your application may take longer to process.

Important information

If you:

- Provide false or misleading information to the Licensing Authority, you may be liable for a fine of up to \$20,000.
- If you work without a licence you could be fined up to \$40,000.

Section 62 of the Private Security Personnel and Private Investigators Act 2010 lists certain grounds that may disqualify you from being granted a certificate of approval. If you meet any of the grounds of disqualification listed below, you will be able to make a statement about your character, circumstances or background.

The Licensing Authority may still grant your application, but only if the Authority is satisfied that you are suitable to work in the class or classes of work to which the application relates. Please note that no refund is payable if your application is unsuccessful.
