#### **Payment information**

There is no filing fee with this application.

#### **Grounds for objection**

You may only file an objection on the grounds:

- that an applicant is disqualified under section 62 or 63 of the Private Security Personnel and Private Investigators Act 2010.
- that there are other reasons relating to the applicant's character, circumstances, or background why the applicant is unsuitable to carry on the class or classes of private security business to which the application relates.

#### After you make an objection

Within seven days of receiving your objection the Licensing Authority will notify the applicant and advise you on how the objection will be processed. The Licensing Authority will do one or more of the following:

- Ask for further information.
- Decide that they have enough information to make a decision.
- Hold a hearing to hear evidence (if this happens you will be given more information).

Once the Licensing Authority decides that they have enough information they will make a decision on whether to grant or refuse the licence. The Licensing Authority will provide you with written notice of their decision.
