## When to use this form

Use this Notice of Appeal form if you are liable for deportation because:

- you are unlawfully in New Zealand; or
- you hold a temporary or interim visa and have been served with Deportation Liability Notice (DLN); or
- your temporary or interim visa was granted in error; or
- you held your temporary or interim visa under a false identity;
- you held a temporary or interim visa and it was determined that there was sufficient reason to deport vou; or
- you are also filing a refugee and protection appeal and are eligible to lodge a humanitarian appeal at the same time

and you would like to appeal to the Immigration and Protection Tribunal (the Tribunal) against your liability for deportation.

If your spouse/partner and/or any adult children (aged 18 and over) are also liable for deportation, each of them must complete a separate appeal form and pay a separate fee.

If you have any dependent children who hold temporary or interim visa and have been served with Deportation Liability Notice (DLN), they must each complete a separate Notice of Appeal form, and depending on their circumstances, they may be required to pay a separate fee. The Tribunal will let you know if this is required.

If you have any dependent children who have NOT been served with a Deportation Liability Notice (DLN) they can be included in your appeal and they do not need to complete a separate appeal form or pay a separate fee.

# What you need with your application

To complete your application, you need to send:

- A fully completed form AND
- The fee for filing this Notice of Appeal (\$700)

You should also send, if you can:

- A copy of your Deportation Liability Notice, or Immigration New Zealand decision, expired visa or a copy of the relevant pages of your passport showing your visa (whichever is applicable)
- Copies of any other documents or evidence you wish to submit in support of your appeal
- A copy of your identification page from your passport

All accompanying documents must be provided in English or with a certified translation in English. The original and one copy of all documents need to be provided.

# Completing the form

- · Complete this form in English.
- You can fill in this form electronically. If you do this, you must also print, sign, and submit it to the Tribunal.
- You can also print and fill in this form by hand. If filling out by hand, please print carefully.
- Answer every question on the form unless the instructions tell you otherwise.
- If you are a minor appellant (under 18 years of age and not married or in a civil union), a responsible adult must sign on your behalf. If you do not have a parent present to act as responsible adult, tick the relevant box in Step 8 of this form and the Tribunal will nominate a responsible adult to act for you.

Please read *Guide 5 – A guide to lodging a deportation appeal by a non-resident* before you start completing this form. The guide will help you assess whether you are entitled to an appeal and provides information on how to lodge an appeal.

## **Application process**

You must lodge this Notice of Appeal form together with your lodgement fee and all relevant documents by email, in person, by courier or by post to the Tribunal at the address at the end of this form. The Tribunal must receive it within the time limit.

If you send a copy of this Notice of Appeal with your proof of payment by email, the Tribunal will accept it on that date but you still need to deliver or post the original of this Notice of Appeal and supporting documents to the Tribunal.

After you have lodged your appeal, the Tribunal will write to let you know that your appeal has been received.

A copy of your appeal will be sent to Immigration New Zealand who will provide any information and/or relevant parts of your immigration file to the Tribunal.

If you change your representative, or your (or your representative's) contact details change, you must notify the Tribunal immediately.

# Terms used in this form

Appellant	An appellant is the person who appeals a decision.
Certified Copy	A true copy, approved by someone legally allowed to approve it. If you are in New Zealand, certified copies must be approved by a lawyer, notary public, Justice of the Peace or court official.
Certified Translation	A written translation from one language into English that has been officially certified by a recognised translation agency. A translation by a friend or family member will not be accepted.
Dependent child	A dependent child means a child under 18 years of age who is not married or in a civil union and who is dependent on you (the principal appellant), whether or not the child is your child.
Minor Appellant	A minor appellant is an appellant who is under 18 years of age and not married or in a civil union.
Principal Appellant	The principal appellant is the main appellant lodging the appeal. If there are dependent children included in the appeal, the parent is the principal appellant.
Representative	A representative must be a lawyer, a licensed immigration adviser, or a licence-exempt person. For the full list, see <i>Guide 5 – A guide to lodging a deportation appeal by a non-resident</i> .
Responsible Adult	This is either the minor appellant's parent or a person nominated by the Tribunal.
