 - A Registrar or Deputy Registrar of a District Court;
 - A Justice of the Peace;
 - A constable;
 - A registered medical professional;
 - A person authorised by law to take statutory declarations in New Zealand.

Who is not:

- A relative or part of the family group of the applicant;
- A spouse, de-facto partner, or civil union partner of the applicant;
- A person who lives at the same address as the applicant;
- The employer of the applicant;
- A business partner of the applicant.

On the back of one of the photographs:

1. Print in his or her own handwriting: **“Certified true likeness of [full name of the applicant]”**; and
2. **MUST** also sign and date the rear of the photograph.

- An officer in the service of the Crown or of a local authority who is authorised for that purpose (including a Police officer of the rank of Sergeant or above, and a Police Declarations Officer);
- Some other person authorised by law to administer an oath.
