



## Make an objection to an application for a licence

Under the Private Security Personnel and Private Investigators Act 2010

### 1 What is this form used for?

Use this form to make an objection against to an individual or company being granted a licence.

### 2 Completing this form

- Print clearly in CAPITALS.
- Use a black or blue pen to complete this form.
- Answer every question on the form unless the instructions tell you otherwise.

### 3 Payment information

There is no fee for making an objection against a licence application.

### 4 Important information

All personal information provided to the PSPLA will be dealt with in accordance with the Privacy Act 1993.

### 5 Under what grounds can you object to an application?

You may only file an objection on the grounds:

- that an applicant is disqualified under section 62 or 63 of the Private Security Personnel and Private Investigators Act 2010
- that there are other reasons relating to the applicant's character, circumstances, or background why the applicant is unsuitable to carry on the class or classes of private security business to which the application relates.

### 6 How long will it take to hear the outcome of your objection?

In normal circumstances it will take 2 months to hear the outcome of your objection.

### 7 What happens after you make an objection?

Within seven days of receiving your objection the Licensing Authority will notify the applicant. The Licensing Authority will consider the objection, then do one or more of the following:

- Ask for further information.
- Decide that he or she has enough information to make a decision.
- Hold a hearing to hear evidence (if this happens you will be given more information).

Once the Licensing Authority decides that they have enough information they will make a decision on whether to grant or refuse the licence. The Licensing Authority will provide you with written notice of their decision.

No objection may be made under this section except on one of the following grounds:

- that the applicant is disqualified on 1 or more grounds in section 62 or 63 of the Private Security Personnel and Private Investigators Act 2010, as the case may be; or
- that there are other reasons relating to the applicant's character, circumstances, or background why the applicant is unsuitable to carry on the class or classes of private security business to which the application relates.

The grounds of objection may relate either to the application as a whole or to any particular class or classes of private security business that the applicant proposes to carry on. The Licensing Authority will serve a copy of the notice of objection on the applicant within 7 days after it is filed with the Licensing Authority.
