**Main issues and opportunities raised at the hui****The Crown’s intent**

- Me matua whakaū i tenei tūranga kia kore ai e turaki i tētehi kāwanatanga whai muri
- Mā te Māori tonu tēnei tūranga e whakahaere.

**Possible Crown/Māori Relations Priorities**

- WAI 2336 - te whakatutuku i te kerēme WAI 2336 a te Kōhanga Reo National Trust
- *Tiriti o Waitangi me te mana ōrite* – te kōrero a tētehi, ko te Tiriti o Waitangi me te mana ōrite kia tawharau i te tūranga hou o the Minita. Kia māturu te mana ōrite ki roto i te whakahaere me ngā hua ka puta i ngā rāngai (mātauranga, haoura, whai mahi)
- *Te reo Māori* - kia ōrite te mana o te reo Māori ki te reo Ingarihi. He tino kaha te ako me te whakatairanga a ētehi Pākehā i te ao tūmatanui, ā mā au a Pākehā te Pākehā e āwhina ki te whai wāhi mai ki te reo
- *Whare herehere* – kia kaua e hanga i te whare herehere hou, me aro kē ki te tīni i te ara e uru atu ai te tangata Māori ki te whare herehere
- *Kura* - Tē eke panuku a ngā tamariki Māori i ngā kura auraki. Me tautoko i ngā kura hourua, e tino whai hua ana mō ngā tamariki Māori.

**Actions:**

- Kāore kau he tāpaetanga i whakatakotoria.
