

## **Bill of Rights Act reports**

Thank you for your email of 29 August 2022, requesting under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), information around two Bill of Rights Act (BORA) reports held by the Ministry of Justice (the Ministry). Specifically, you requested:

"I am requesting all official information regarding the following two reports prepared by the Ministry of Justice:

Consistency with the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990: Water Services Entities Bill, dated 25 May 2022

Consistency with the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990: Pae Ora (Healthy Futures) Bill, dated 12 October 2021."

On 2 September 2022, your request was clarified in accordance with section 15 of the Act. You clarified that you sought the basis of the reasoning for these reports.

The reasoning for our conclusions is set out in the finalised reports, and includes references to relevant cases. The finalised reports are available on our website:

Therefore, I am refusing to provide these to you under section 18(d) of the Act, as the information is publicly available.

We note that the reports are the Ministry's view on the introduction version of the Bills' compliance with BORA. Whether the Bill as enacted is complaint with BORA is a matter for the courts.
