Information for the Specialist Courts and Tribunals Centre

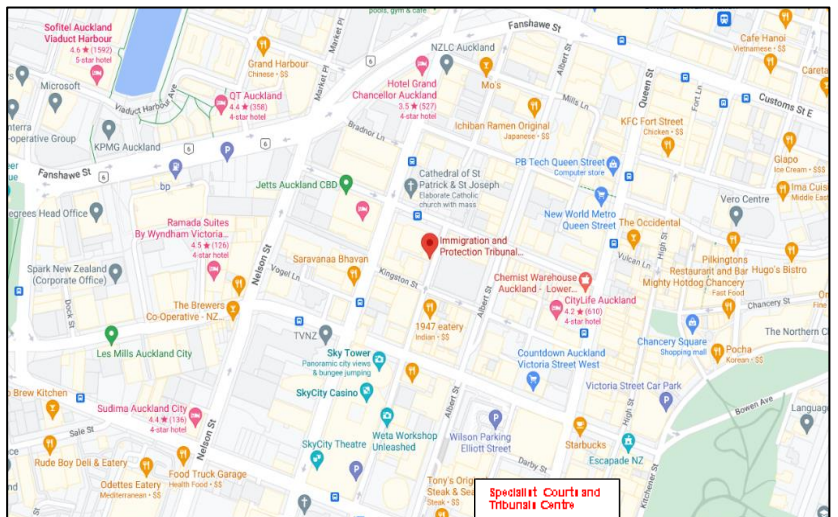
Nau mai haere mai and welcome to the Specialist Courts and Tribunals Centre in Auckland. Here are some things you will find useful for your visit.

Location

Specialist Courts and Tribunals Centre, 41 Federal Street, Auckland CBD.

Federal St is a one-way street – there is no direct access from Wyndham St, you must approach from either Kingston St, Victoria St W or Wellesley St W.

Security

Court Security Officers (CSOs) are located in the main lobby next to the escalators – please follow the instructions of the CSOs on arrival.

Access

Access generally is up the escalators. The elevator is restricted to swipe card access only. Should you require lift access, however, please talk to a CSO, push the call button to the left of the lift or contact Reception on Level 1 (09) 914 4299; Level 2 (09) 916 9091.

- Access to hearing rooms 4 and courtroom 5 is on Level 1, via the corridor at the top of the first tier escalator.
- Access to courtrooms 2.01 and 2.02 and hearing room 2.03 is on Level 2, through the glass doors at the top of the second tier escalator.



Public Transport

Trains and buses

Britomart is around a 7-minute walk (650 metres) from the Specialist Courts and Tribunals Centre. When you leave Britomart walk south towards the Sky Tower. Please check the latest information about timetables on Auckland Transport's website or app.

Buses

There are a number of bus links in the area and currently there are various bus stops on:

- Wyndham Street
- Hobson Street
- Fanshawe Street (at the bottom of Bradnor Lane)

Bus stops are often relocated by Auckland Transport. Please check the latest information on the Auckland Transport's website or app.

Car parking

There are various paid parking options near the Specialist Courts and Tribunals Centre.

Parking fees are subject to change – please check rates directly with provider prior to using any of these car parks.

Federal St is one-way from Wellesley St W towards Wyndham St (easiest access to SkyCity Parking and Federal St Car Park); Hobson St is one-way towards Southern motorway on-ramp (easiest access to Farmers Carpark). There is no access to Federal St directly from Wyndham St.

Street parking

Limited paid street parking is available on streets in the immediate vicinity. Time limits apply to all street parking.

Drop-offs

Taxi drop-off: Tell the taxis to go to 41 Federal St, next door to Rydges Hotel. There is a taxi stand outside Rydges Hotel where taxis might wait.

Loading zones for drop-off: There is a 5-minute loading zone on Federal St near the intersection with Wyndham St. Remember to approach from Kingston/Victoria Sts or Wellesley St W as Federal St is a one-way street with no entry from Wyndham St.

Refreshment options

There are a number of cafes and takeaway options around the Specialist Courts and Tribunals Centre:

Federal St: Kingston Café, Rydges and Maru Sushi & Don

Wyndham St: Mojo, Caffe Greco and Hollywood Bakery

Federal Square (behind the Cathedral of St Patrick and St Joseph): Federal Square Café, Daily Bread, Sumo Sushi
