LEGAL ADVICE CONSISTENCY WITH THE NEW ZEALAND BILL OF RIGHTS ACT 1990: New Zealand Day Bill

- 1. We have considered the New Zealand Day Bill ("the Bill") for consistency with the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990 (the "Bill of Rights Act"). The Bill is a Member's Bill in the name of Hon Peter Dunne MP.
- 2. The New Zealand Day Bill seeks to rename Waitangi Day and to regularise its celebration on the Monday of any week in which 6 February falls. It also seeks to repeal the Waitangi Day Act 1976.
- 3. We have come to the conclusion that this Bill appears to be consistent with the Bill of Rights Act.
- 4. In accordance with your instructions, we attach a copy of this opinion for referral to the Minister of Justice. We also attach a copy for referral to Hon Peter Dunne MP, if you agree.
