AMENDED DECISION

- [1] Mr Faaiviivi has filed an application for a Certificate with the Licensing Authority of Secondhand Dealers and Pawnbrokers under s 21 of the Secondhand Dealers and Pawnbrokers Act 2004 (the Act).
- [2] Section 22(a) of the Act states that a person is disqualified from holding a certificate if he has been convicted of a specified offence within the last five years. Specified offence is defined in s 4 of the Act and includes any offence under ss 217 to 265 of the Crimes Act 1961.
- [3] Mr Faaiviivi was convicted of an offence under s 226 of the Crimes Act in June 2012. Offences under s 226 of the Crimes Act fall within the definition of a specified offence. Therefore Mr Faaiviivi is disqualified from holding a certificate until 27 June 2017. The Authority has no discretion to waive such disqualification under s 23 of the Act as waiver is unable to be considered for people who have been convicted of specified offences within the last five years.

Conclusion

[4] As Mr Faaiviivi is disqualified from holding a certificate until 27 June 2017 and his application is declined.
