DECISION OF THE MAORI APPELLATE COURT

This is an appeal made by Karanema Norman Greening against a Final Order of the Court made at Hastings on 8 June 1992 under Section 78A of the Maori Affairs Amendment Act 1967 in respect of land interests in the estate of James Greening, deceased.


This application was part heard at Hastings on Wednesday 25 November 1992. After certain directions issued from the Maori Appellate Court the proceedings were adjourned and set down for further hearing at Hastings on Wednesday 17 February 1993.


Mr J.F McDowell, Counsel for the Appellant, has now by letter dated 13 January sought leave to abandon the appeal.


There is an Order under Section 45 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953 dismissing the appeal.

The question of costs is reserved pending submissions from counsel and a further decision on this matter will be issued in due course.
