 - 1. Whether, when a surviving de facto partner has chosen option B under s 61 of the Property (Relationships) Act 1976, s 95 of that Act precludes an application under s 25(1)(a) by a personal representative of the deceased partner for a division of the relationship property with leave granted under s 88(2) of the Act?
 - 2. If such an application is not precluded, whether the grant of administration to the Public Trustee should nevertheless be set aside and a grant made to the appellant?
