JUDGMENT OF THE COURT

- A The application for leave to appeal is granted ([2014] NZCA 489).
- B The approved question is whether the Court of Appeal was right to conclude that an inculpatory statement made by Mr Kumar to undercover police officers was improperly obtained and should not be admitted in evidence at his trial.
